

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how **Armoni Bilgisayar Limited Şirketi** uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit <https://armoni.com/>. It sets out which cookies we use, why we use them, how you can manage them, and what rights you have under the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) and, since our company is established in Türkiye, under Turkish Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698 (“KVKK”).

Except for strictly necessary cookies, we place cookies on your device only after you have given **explicit consent**, and you may withdraw that consent at any time. Through the cookie management panel on our site you can see every category of cookie we use, switch each non-essential category on or off, and change your choices whenever you wish.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that a website places on your browser and reads on later visits. Cookies may store information such as your session, your language preference, or how long you spent on a page.

We use cookies to keep the site working correctly, to remember your preferences, and to improve our services.

Types of cookies

By duration

Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser and exist only to maintain continuity during a single visit.

Persistent cookies remain on your device after the browser is closed and are deleted at the end of a defined period or when you remove them.

By origin

First-party cookies are set directly by the website you are visiting — in this case armoni.com.

Third-party cookies are set by a domain other than the one you are visiting.

By purpose

1) Strictly necessary cookies

Required for the site to function. They handle session management, form submission, security verification, language routing, and remembering your privacy choices. If these cookies are blocked, parts of the site may not work correctly. Strictly necessary cookies do not require your consent.

2) Functional cookies

Used to personalise your experience, for example by remembering the language you selected.

3) Analytics / performance cookies

Allow us to measure statistics such as visitor numbers, traffic sources, which pages are viewed most often, and how visitors move through the site. We use this data to evaluate and improve the site’s performance.

4) Advertising / marketing cookies

Enable personalised advertising based on browsing behaviour and allow the effectiveness of campaigns to be measured.

Note: We do not currently use any advertising or marketing cookies on this website. The category remains defined in our cookie management panel so that, if such cookies are introduced in the future, your consent can be requested separately for them.

Purposes of processing and legal bases

Strictly necessary cookies are used to deliver the core functions of our website, maintain security, operate language routing, ensure the demo request form is transmitted correctly and safely, and remember your privacy preferences. Personal data collected through these cookies is processed on the basis of our legitimate interests (GDPR Art. 6(1)(f)) and, where relevant, the performance of a contract (GDPR Art. 6(1)(b)). Under the KVKK, the corresponding grounds are Article 5(2)(c) and 5(2)(f).

Functional cookies are used so that the language you choose is remembered on your next visit.

Analytics / performance cookies are used to measure the performance of our website, monitor visitor traffic and understand user interactions. We use Google Analytics for this purpose.

Advertising / marketing cookies, if introduced in the future, will be used to measure campaign performance and to present content relevant to your interests.

All cookies other than strictly necessary ones are placed only on the basis of your **explicit consent** (GDPR Art. 6(1)(a); KVKK Art. 5(1)). Until you give that consent, these cookies are not written to your device.

Third-party services we use

Google Analytics — Used to measure website traffic and user behaviour. Technical data such as your IP address, device information and page navigation records are collected in the process. It runs only after you have given consent; where consent is not given, Google Consent Mode prevents data collection and cookie storage.

Google Fonts — Loads the typefaces used on the site from Google's servers. Your IP address is transmitted to Google during loading.

Cloudflare — Our demo request form uses a security check (Cloudflare Turnstile) to block automated and malicious submissions. Technical data such as your IP address is transmitted to the service provider during this check.

CookieAdmin — The cookie management tool used to display the consent notice and store your preferences.
